


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



- Rem ove left and right timing chain covers. Refer to → Chapter "Left and Right Timing Chain Covers".


Insert guide pin of A dapter -T40058-so - that large diam eter-arrow 1-points to engine. Sm all diam eter-arrow 2-points to adapter.



Using Socket-T40058-, rotate crankshaft in direction of engine rotation -arrow - to TDC.









Mount the Cam shaft Locating Tool-T40070-on both cylinder heads and tighten the bolts-arrows-to 20 Nm.




If the tensioning element is to be removed from the chain tensioner, observe the installed position: Hole in housing floor faces tow and chain tensioner, piston faces toward tensioning rail.






- Set the Counter-Holder-T10172-with Pin -T10172/2-in place on the cam shaft adjuster of the right exhaust cam shaft.
- Hold the cam shaft timing chain pretensioned by pressing on counter-holder in direction of -arrow -.
- Simultaneously, pre-torque the cam shaft boltusing the Multipoint Socket-T10035- and torque wrench.
- 1 Tightening Specifications: 40 Nm.
- Continue holding the pretension on the exhaust cam shaft and pre-torque the bolt-1-on the intake cam shaft.
- 1 Tightening Specifications: 40 Nm.









U sing K ey -T40058-turn crankshaft two - complete rotations in direction of engine rotation -arrow -until crankshaft stands at TDC again.



If rotated unintentionally beyond TDC , turn back crankshaft again approxim ately  $30^{\circ}$  and set to TDC again .









\_ Mount the Cam shaft Locating Tools -T40070-to both cylinder heads and tighten the bolts -arrows-to 20 Nm.

The Cam shaft Locating Tool-T40070-is 1 connectly positioned when the holes for the cylinder head bolts remain free.

- Screw the Crankshaft Holder-T40069-directly into the hole.

The CrankshaftHolder-T40069-must engage in the locating hole of the crankshaft-1-, otherwise repeat the adjustment.



- Remove cam shaft locating tools on both cylinder heads.
- Remove crankshaftholder.
- Screw sealing plug of TDC marking with new sealinto cylinder block.

Further installation is in reverse order of rem oval, note the following:
