

## Audi Q5 Checklist

### Pre-Pickup

- Digital camera
- Price quote documentation
- Car insurance paperwork - insurance coverage and proof of insurance

### At Pickup (inside vehicle)

- Two keys
- Valet key and holder in the glove box or received from dealer
- All manuals and maintenance log
- Audi Roadside Assistance card
- Verify that the VIN on the vehicle matches the paperwork
- Verify options on car
  - All weather mats and trunk liner
  - Carpeted floor mats included
  - 3.5mm iPod adapter cable
  - Tow Hitch
  - Bang & Olufsen sound system
  - 19" Wheels
  - Wheel locks
  - Navigation system (and backup camera)
  - Roof bars with rubber inserts
- Check oil level - use MMI interface
- Any upholstery rips and tears and stains?
- Vinyl surfaces clean
- No scratches on plastic trim
- Interior vanity & map lights
- Glove box light
- Instrument panel lights
- Window and door lock switches lit?
- Odometer reading doesn't show excessive mileage; should not be more than 20-25 miles.
- Verify full fuel tank
- Trip computer displays and switches.
- Wipers work: on normal speeds.
- Wipers work in interval mode. In interval mode, does thumbwheel vary the interval?
- Horn works.
- All windows go up & down fully.
- All window controls work.
- All door lock controls work.
- External mirror adjustment buttons work
- Seat heaters work.
- Front driver seat adjust fully up/down, forward/backward, recline
- Front passenger seat adjust fully up/down, forward/backward, recline
- Front Seats are tight and rattle-free with no rocking.
- Front seat belts work properly.
- Rear seats slide and fold properly
- Rear seats are tight and rattle-free with no rocking.
- Rear seat belts work properly.
- Test one or more regular audio CD's, one or more MP3 CD's, one or more DVDs

- Verify that your Sirius trial subscription has been activated
- Verify operation of all A/C vents at various speeds

### Hatch

- Hatch light works
- Front license plate holder in right rear cubbyhole
- Spare tire present?
- Tools present:
  - Jack
  - Security key for locking/unlocking wheel lug bolts
  - Wheel cover puller
  - Screwdriver
  - Lug wrench
  - Towing eye-bolt
  - Air compressor should be in left rear compartment
  - Roof rails present - includes rubber insert
  - Cargo cover present
  - Cargo protection net included? (would be in black bag)

### At Pickup (outside vehicle)

- Check door alignments
- Check tire pressure - bring your own gauge
  - Should be at recommended pressure - 32 psi - verify on door panel
- What brand are the tires?
  - (Michelin Latitude Tour HP, Conti CrossContact LX Sport, GY Excellence or Dunlop Grandtrek Touring)
  - Do they match the car's spec? (should be all-weather)
- No dealership sticker/emblem
- Drive the vehicle in the parking lot - check for low speed wheel shudder when turning tightly
- Steering wheel properly aligned
- Both key fobs work: lock and unlock the car, unlock the hatch; the "panic" button works.
- Take pictures from all angles, from far back as well as close-up.
- Perfect paint: no chips or scratches. And no graffiti in hidden places like on door jamb.
- Windshield & Windows clean & undamaged.
- Headlight & taillight lenses clear, undamaged, no condensation.
- All lights verified to work from outside
- Head lights(high beam/low beam)
- Fog lights
- Parking lights
- Brake lights
- Reverse backup lights
- Directional signals
- Car washed and detailed

## **Break-In Requirements**

### **For the first 600 miles**

- Do not use full throttle
- Do not drive at engine speeds that are more than 2/3 of the maximum permitted RPM
- Note: new brake pads do not have a full braking effect during the first 250 miles

### **From 600 to 1,000 miles**

- Speeds can gradually be increased to the maximum permissible road or engine speed

### **During and after break-in period**

- Do not rev the engine up to speeds when it is cold. this applies whether the transmission is in N or in gear.

### **After break-in period**

- Do not exceed maximum engine speed under any circumstances.
- Upshift into the next higher gear before reaching the red area at the end of the tachometer scale

Also when picking up, see if they are willing to throw in one or more of these:

Exhaust tips (for 2.0T)

Extra liter of oil (I hear these cars drink plenty)

License plate frames
